Texas offers superior transportation and logistical advantages. The state's central location and state-of-the-art transportation network provide timely access to domestic and global markets via air, land, and sea.



Texas is home to American Airlines and Southwest Airlines, two of the largest airlines in the world.



More than 10.9 million tons of freight were shipped through Texas' two intermodal facilities in 2011.



In 2011, Texas' 46 railroad operators transported 379.3 million tons of freight.



Houston is the top U.S. exporting market. The Houston-Sugar Land-Baytown area exported \$110.3 billion in 2012.



Texas is the only state with its own power grid and is not subject to federal regulation over electrical transmission.



Fort Worth's Alliance Airport at the Alliance Global Logistics Hub is the world's first purely industrial airport.
