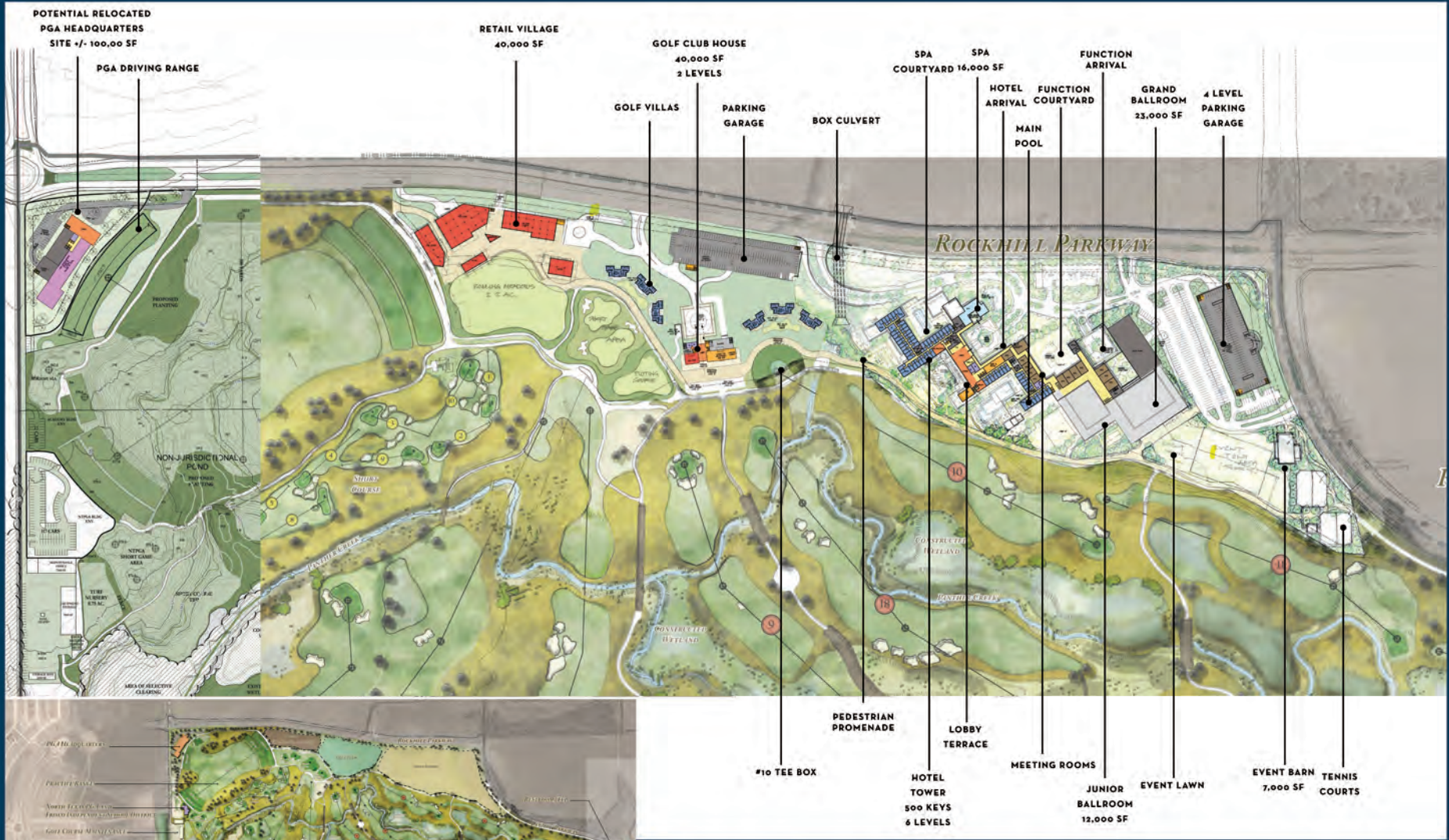

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The PGA of America is teaming with Omni Stillwater Woods (OSW), a joint venture led by Omni Hotels & Resorts with Stillwater Capital and Woods Capital; the City of Frisco, as well as its Economic and Community Development Corporations; and the Frisco Independent School District. The 600-acre, \$500 million dollar project will include two (2) championship golf courses, 10-hole short course and practice areas totaling 46 holes; a clubhouse; Class AA office space; a 500-room Omni resort with attached 127,000 square-foot conference center; a technologically advanced retail village; parks and open space plus several miles of trails to complement the unique signature development.
